Dear Shri Om Prakash

Please find enclosed herewith a copy of order dated 10/04/2015 of the Honble Supreme Court of India in the above noted case. The Honble Court has issued the following directions to the State/District Legal Service Authorities:

- (1) The Member Secretaries of the State Legal Services Authorities shall take up the issue for compliance of the directions issued by the Supreme Cout in Laxmi Vs. Union of India [(2014) 4 SCC 427] with the respective State Governments so that a minimum of Rs. 3 lakh is made available to each vibitim of acid attack.
- (2) The Member Secretary of the State Legal Services Authority shall obtain a copy of the Victim Compensation Scheme from the State Government/UT Administration and shall give it wide and adequate publicity in the State/Union Territory so that each acid attack victim in the States/Union Territories can take the benefit of the Victim Compensation Scheme.
- (3) In case any compensation claim is made by any acid attack victim, the matter will be taken up by the District Legal Services Authority, through a Board, which will include the District Judge and such other co-opted persons who the District Judge feels will be of assistance, particularly the District Magistrate, the Superintendent of Police and the Civil Surgeon or the Chief Medical Officer of that District or their nominee, to function as the Criminal Injuries Compensation Board for all purposes.
- (4) The District Legal Services Authority shall ensure that due publicity is given to the observations of the Hon'ble Supreme Court that the private hospitals should provide full treatment to the victims of acid attack including medicines, food, bedding and reconstructive surgeries and the obligation of the hospital, where the victim of an acid attack is first treated, to issue a certificate that the individual is a victim of an acid attack, so that such certificate can be used for

treatment and reconstructive surgeries or any other scheme that the victim may be entitled to with the State Government or the Union Territory, as the

- (5) The Member Secretary of the State Legal Services Authority will ensure that the order dated 10/04/2015 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is forwarded to the Secretary of each District Legal Services Authority who will ensure that due publicity is given to the order of the Hon'ble Court.
- You are requested to take necessary steps for compliance of the directions given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the aforesaid matter.
- You are also requested to ensure that wide publicity of the Victim Compensation Scheme and orders dated 10.04.2015 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in your State/UT is given as an ongoing exercise so that the victims can avail compensation under Section 357A and treatment under Section 357C of the Cr.P.C., 1973. A compliance report may be sent to this Authority to facilitate submission of compliance report to the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
